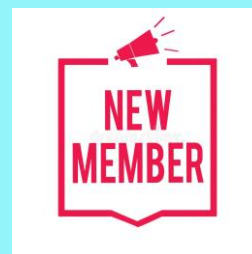

Rimern report from AGM

As at end June 23

- Agencies – now 36
- 260 Case managers now trained
- Vounteers – 83 registered but many more who are ad hoc. Always need more – especially 2nd + 5th Saturday of each month.
- 230 orders have been despatched to value of \$326,00 (double last financial year)
- Average home furnishing order is \$1400
- Over 10,000 major items rehomed (excluding small items like cutlery etc)
- Up to 12 clients per week can be accommodated.
- Organising RIMERN pull-up banners which we can use.
- Anyone with good condition electrical household goods no longer needed please bring to meetings and Heather will take them to warehouse.
- PV should have a meeting at warehouse early next year where we can bring a friend, look over place and either have some Uber food delivered or eat at nearby hotel. Great way to encourage new members as well
