Hello to All,

As the coordinator in your club of the 2000 Toiletry Kits that we collectively distributed to schools in Alice Springs Remote, I am very pleased to advise you that the rates of trachoma have improved dramatically.

In 2019, the statistics showed that 18.3% of kids aged 5-9 yrs old across the 25 communities that were screened, had trachoma. The latest reading has dropped dramatically to 3.7%. That is 3.7% of the kids aged 5-9yrs old from the 21 communities screened in the area of Alice Springs Remote, have trachoma. That is a huge reduction.

Whilst I know a lot of you (by assumption) will not have received a response from the school that you supplied, please note that what you and your club provided has to have had an impact on the screening results. In the 5 years I have been working on the EndTrachoma project, I have not seen such a positive change in statistics like this one.

From the EndTrachoma team, please share this big achievement with your members along with a big thank you. Results like this are what this project set out to achieve and doing it with so many partners has been and still is fantastic.


